



AMBER MOTOTOUR BALTICS 2025

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Amber Mototour Baltics 2025 (hereinafter referred to as "the Mototour") is open to all motorcycle riders and passengers. The primary objective of the Mototour is to explore Baltic States – Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia by riding designated sightseeing routes, visiting historical and natural sites, experiencing local cuisine, and learning about Baltic States heritage.

1. Mototour

The Mototour is organized by the Association "Amber Family" (hereinafter referred to as "the Organiser"). The event will comply with local traffic laws and respect environmental and safety regulations.

2. Participation

The Mototour is open to all riders and their passengers.

2.1. Drivers must:

- Possess a valid motorcycle driving license.
- Have at least medium-level motorcycle riding experience.

2.2. Passengers cannot register without an accompanying driver.

2.3. Participants must be in good health and physically fit for long-distance motorcycle travel in tropical conditions.

3. Registration

To register participant must visit the website www.ambermototour.com and purchase the mototour. After purchasing, registration form is going to be asked to fill.

The deadline of registration is 2025 June 06th. For the late requests, please contact the Organiser separately.

The participant has to provide the number of ID card or passport. During the first meeting of the event, participant must show this document to prove his/her identity.

Organiser stores participants' data in accordance with Lithuanian law regulations (The Law on Legal Protection of Personal Data, 19 - 2022-11-24), concerning methods of personal data storage. A participant has the right to inspect his/her data, make changes or remove his/her personal data from Organiser's database by contacting the Organiser via e-mail.

4. Registration Fee

4.1. The registration fee is fixed by the Organiser and must be paid in Euros (€) in full until **2025 June 06th**, to the following account:

4.2. Full registration fee for the rider in a double shared room **2195 Eur** (€).

4.3. Full registration fee for the rider in a private single room **2,495 EUR** (€).

4.4. Full registration fee for the passenger in a double shared room **1,795 EUR** (€).

4.5. The transfer costs are to be paid by the sender.

4.6. If the total amount is not received 45 days before the mototour starts, Organiser reserves the right to vacate the participant's place in the group.

4.7. The registration fee includes/not includes

4.7.1. Inclusions:

- Pick up from the airport if needed;
- Motorcycle;
- Accommodation in 3-5 stars hotels;
- Meals - daily breakfast, lunch, dinner (6 breakfasts, 7 lunches, 7 dinners);
- Backup vehicle;
- Support staff – Mechanics, Guides & Road Captain with motorcycle;
- Entry tickets for sightseeing locations (as per itinerary);
- Basic first-aid kit;
- Welcome bag (T-shirt of the Mototour included);
- Road tolls (where applicable);
- Ferry boat tickets.

4.7.2. Exclusions:

- Fuel;
- Items of personal nature visa, tips, room service, laundry, mineral water, alcoholic or nonalcoholic beverages, phone calls, additional sightseeing tours / excursions not included in the itinerary etc.;
- Any items / services not specifically mentioned in the 'Inclusion' column;

- Basic riding gear, including riding gloves, waistpouch etc. (can be arranged upon request);
- Accident or medical insurance, or any medical expenses in the unlikely case of an accident.

4.8. If participant doesn't require a motorcycle the following prices shall be applied:

4.8.1. Full registration fee for the rider in a double shared room **1,795 EUR (€)**.

4.8.2. Full registration fee for the rider in a private single room **2,095 EUR (€)**.

5. Cancellation Policy

In the case of registration cancellation, participant must contact the Organiser via e-mail info@ambermototour.com and get the confirmation.

5.1. The reimbursed:

- if registration is cancelled until the 06^h of June– 100 percent is refunded.
- if registration is canceled until the 21st of June – 50 percent is refunded.
- if cancelations are done after the 21st of June - no refund.

5.2. If, after vacating the participant's place on the mototour, the mototour is not fully booked, the participant may pay the missing amount to the total balance and take part in the mototour he/she originally booked.

5.3. In case of accidental circumstances that unable participant to take part in the mototour, the registration fee can be transferred to another mototour. But no refund can be done, if such circumstances occurs in less than 30 days before the mototour. The possibility of transferring the registration fee depends on successful negotiations between Organiser and accommodations, catering and other partners of the mototour. Organiser reserves the right to charge the registration fee (full or partial) if mototour partners do not agree to cancel reservations without charging advance payments.

6. Accommodation

Organiser attempts to allocate participants in high quality hotels, in double rooms. Specification of kinds of rooms offered are presented in detailed tour specification. A limited number of single rooms are usually available at extra cost, but availability cannot be guaranteed.

7. Baggage

Organiser supplies the possibility to load one baggage item per person into the escort car. The rest baggage should be carried by the participant.

Organiser assumes no responsibility for a participant's baggage loss or damage. Baggage insurance is recommended. It is suggested to have a top case empty for temporary helmet storage, as leaving helmets on handlebars is not recommended.

8. Photo and video material

Photos and videos produced by the Organisers or its group leaders on the mototour are the property of the association "Amber Family" and copyrights rest with them. Organiser can use all such material for advertising and marketing purposes, including images in which individual mototour members can be recognized, without any charge from the participant arising for the Organiser for this use of material.

9. Passport, visa, driving and health regulations, insurance

- 9.1. The participant is responsible for complying with regulations concerning passport, visa, healthcare, traffic and all consequences resulting from non-compliance.
- 9.2. It is strongly recommended to have the valid health insurance for the period of the mototour. The health insurance is the responsibility of the participant.

10. Responsibility

- 10.1. Organiser is responsible for providing the services listed in the mototour description. Organiser carefully selects and constantly checks its contractors, such as hotels, restaurants and local tourist guides. Organiser is responsible for conscientious travel preparations.
- 10.2. Participants are responsible for obtaining valid health and travel insurance covering the Mototour duration.
- 10.3. The Organiser shall not be held liable for any accidents, injuries, or losses incurred during the event.
- 10.4. The Organiser reserves the right to alter or cancel the Mototour due to unforeseen circumstances. Liability is limited to twice the participant's paid fee.
- 10.5. The Organiser is not responsible for delays, schedule changes, or force majeure events beyond their control.
- 10.6. The Organiser is not responsible for cancellations, delays, or changes caused by force majeure events, including but not limited to natural disasters, political unrest, or unforeseen travel restrictions.
- 10.7. Participants acknowledge that motorcycle touring carries inherent risks, including but not limited to accidents, road conditions, and weather.
- 10.8. By registering, participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Organiser, its employees, and affiliates from any claims, injuries, damages, or losses incurred before, during, or after the event.
- 10.10. Participants must sign a liability waiver before joining the Mototour.

11. Cancellation of the Mototour

- 11.1. The organiser can cancel the mototour:
- if, at the closing date, the number of entries is less than 5;
 - in case of absolute necessity.
- 11.2. In this case, the participants will be notified immediately. Organiser will offer to operate the mototour if all customers agree to a supplemental charge due to the low number of mototour members.
- 11.3. If participants do not accept to pay the supplement, Organiser will refund their payment in full (100 percent), which will constitute the full settlement. This includes, but is not limited to, the cost of pre-paid tickets, hotel reservations and transportation costs. Organiser is not liable for any additional costs (e.g., airfare, visas, etc.) or losses incurred by the participant due to Organiser's cancellation of mototour.
- 11.4. Organiser is not required to make refunds once a mototour commences, regardless of the reason for participant's being unable to complete his/her mototour.

12. Weather conditions

Organiser strives to schedule the mototour at a time of the year when the weather for mototouring is usually suitable. The Organiser is not responsible for weather-related inconveniences, and no refunds will be issued due to adverse weather conditions.

13. Copyrights

All rights reserved. Routes, texts, pictures, graphics, sound, animations and videos as well as their arrangement on the Organiser's website, social media profiles are subject to copyright laws and other protective laws. The content from the website may not be copied, distributed, revised or made accessible to third parties for commercial purposes.

Participants consent to the use of their images for promotional and marketing purposes without additional compensation.

14. Governing Law

The Mototour and any disputes arising from it shall be governed by the laws of Lithuania.

15. Recommendations to Road Users

Show respect on the roads

- Participants must respect local laws, cultural norms, and fellow travelers.
- Reckless or dangerous riding will not be tolerated and may result in expulsion from the Mototour without refund.
- The use of alcohol or drugs before or during riding hours is strictly prohibited.
- Participants must follow group riding etiquette and the instructions of the Organiser's staff.

Noise annoyance

- Ride politely and limit noise pollution by using your horn only in an emergency.
- Use a standard or another quiet exhaust system and keep audio systems at a low level.

Environmental care

- Save petrol and reduce pollution by avoiding unnecessary idling of engines.
- Respect nature by not travelling on paths which risk being damaged beyond a point of natural recovery.
- Protect wildlife and its natural habitat by riding intelligently.
- Ensure that your used oil, tyres, batteries and other recyclable items are properly recycled.
- Encourage a rational use of fuel and space economy by using motorcycles instead of driving automobiles.
